In RFP Attachment 6.3 - Cost Proposal, our interpretation of the cost proposal is that the Benefit Management rate should be inclusive of premiums and cost-sharing, but we simply wish to clarify that point.</p>	<p>The Benefit Management rate to be used in the cost proposal is not to include the premiums and cost sharing expenses. Payments for these expenses will be funded by the state in accordance with Section A.6.f. of the Pro forma contract.</p>

If the Benefit Management Rate to be used in the cost proposal is intended to be inclusive of premiums and cost-sharing expenses as well as all other program expenses, should the proposer use the established monthly maximum of \$1,500 per client per month for the premium and cost-sharing portion or some lesser amount based on our own experience with the program.</p>	<p>Please see response to question 2</p>
