Dr. Ruth Bailey, President, called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m. Dr. Bailey determined that a quorum was present in order to conduct Board business.

MINUTES: Dr. James Smith made a motion to accept the Minutes from the September 16-17, 2010 meeting. Second was given by Ms. Katherine Cherry. Motion carried. Ms. Cherry made a motion to approve the teleconference Minutes for December 17, 2010 and January 14, 2011. Second was given by Dr. John Douglass. Motion Carried.

APPLICANT INTERVIEWS:

Ashley Irwin Ms. Irwin appeared before the Board requesting approval of her application for registration as a dental assistant. Documents in her application file revealed that she is currently on criminal probation for a class A misdemeanor assault until September, 2011. Dr. Douglass made a motion to approve and place license on probation to run concurrent with court ordered probation. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

Pamela Thompson Ms. Thompson appeared before the Board requesting approval of her application for registration as a dental assistant. On her application, Ms. Thompson indicated that she had performed monitoring of nitrous oxide and exposed radiographs prior to becoming

licensed and/or certified to do so. Dr. Lawrence Hsia made a motion to approve the registration upon payment of a civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and proof of continuing education (CE) hours for the years 2003 until present. If she cannot show proof of CE during the specified period, she must pay an additional civil penalty in the amount of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) and make up the number hours she is deficient. Second was given by Dr. James Smith. Motion Carried.

Jamie Wilkerson Ms. Wilkerson appeared before the Board requesting approval of her application for registration as a dental assistant. The documents in her application file revealed that she is currently on criminal probation until September 2011, as a part of her guilty plea to a class A misdemeanor of driving under the influence. Dr. Michael Tabor made a motion to approve the application and place the license on probation to run concurrent with the court ordered probation. Second was given by Dr. Smith. Motion Carried.

Mina Bates Ms. Bates submitted an application for registration as a dental assistant. On the application, she indicated that she had performed monitoring oxide, application of sealants, and exposure of radiographs without the registration and/or certification to do so. Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the application upon payment of a civil penalty in the amount of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150). Second was given by Dr. Isaac Fordjour. Motion Carried.

Kimberly McCollom Ms. McCollom appeared before the Board requesting approval of her application for registration as a dental assistant. The documents in her application file revealed that she had been convicted of several criminal offenses and is currently on probation for those convictions until December 2012. Dr. Hsia made a motion to approve the application and place the license on probation to run concurrent with the court ordered probation. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

Megan Reilly Ms. Reilly appeared before the Board to request approval of her application for licensure as a dental hygienist based on completion of the Central Regional Dental Testing Service (CRDTS) dental hygiene exam. Dr. Douglass made a motion to accept the exam and approve the application. Second was given by Dr. Smith. Motion Carried.

Katrina Frierson Ms. Frierson appeared before the Board to request approval of her application for registration as a dental assistant. The documents in her application file revealed that she had been convicted of multiple criminal offenses. Dr. Hsia made a motion to approve with proof of qualified CPR. Second was given by Ms. Fox. Motion Carried.

Daranee Versluis Dr. Versluis appeared before the Board requesting approval of her Limited Educational License application. The verification from the Minnesota Board of Dentistry showed that Dr. Versluis's license had been voided/voluntarily terminated. Maryam Kassae advised the Board that the candidate does not qualify because she was not licensed before she applied, but that the Board could carve out a section of the rules under special circumstances, to justify applicant credentials based on background and criteria. The Board reviewed the applicant's credentials and experience and made the following decision based on its findings specific to the applicant. Dr. Holt made a motion to approve based on post

graduate training received in the United States and previous teaching experience in the United States. Second was given by Dr. Tabor. Motion Carried.

Cimara Ferreira Dr. Ferreira appeared before the Board requesting approval of her Limited Educational License. The verification letter from the Florida Department of Health showed her dental teaching permit status as null and void. Maryam Kassaei advised the Board that the candidate does not qualify because she was not licensed before she applied, but that the Board could carve out a section of the rules under special circumstances, to justify applicant credentials based on background and criteria. The Board reviewed the applicant's credentials and experience and made the following decision based on its findings specific to the applicant. Dr. Tabor made a motion to approve based on multiple post doctrinal degrees and implant training. Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. Motion Carried.

Rita Addington Ms. Addington interviewed with the Board by teleconference and requested approval of her application for registration as a dental assistant. Her application revealed that she had exposed radiographs and done coronal polishing for a number of years before becoming registered or certified to do so. Ms. Cherry made a motion to deny this application and allow Ms. Addington to reapply with more detailed information as to the duties she performed before application. Second was given by Dr. Tabor. Motion Carried.

Alice Halstead D.D.S. Dr. Halstead appeared before the Board requesting approval of her application for reactivation. Dr. Halstead had not practiced dentistry for over five years. Ms. Fox made a motion to approve. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

Deborah Miller Ms. Miller appeared before the board requesting approval of her reapplication for licensure as a dental hygienist. Ms. Miller had not worked as a dental hygienist since 1990. Ms. Cherry made a motion requiring Ms. Miller to obtain competency evaluation at a hygiene school or take the Southern Regional Testing Agency (SRTA) examination. Second was given by Dr. Smith. Motion Carried. Dr. Douglass can review the application after evaluation for approval.

Marcia Shuffett Ms. Shuffett appeared before the Board requesting approval of her application for reinstatement as a dental hygienist. Ms. Shuffett had not worked as a dental hygienist since 1999. Dr. Fordjour made a motion requiring Ms. Shuffett to obtain competency evaluation at a hygiene school or take the SRTA examination. Second was given by Dr. Holt. Motion Carried. Dr. Douglass can review the application after evaluation for approval.

APPLICATIONS:

The Board considered the request of **Jason Pollei**, DDS to accept the Council of Interstate Testing Agencies (CITA) exam for licensure by criteria. Dr. Pollei had four and one-half years of practice and had completed an orthodontic residency. Dr. Holt made a motion to accept the exam. Second was given by Dr. Smith. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed the Deep Sedation/General Anesthesia Permit Application of **Franklin Taylor** previously denied by the Board Consultant. Motion was made and seconded to ratify the denial. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed a request for waiver of competency testing for reactivation of the dental license of **Deanthia Childs-Wiggins** based on Dr. Wiggins having recently worked in another state as a dentist. Dr. Holt made a motion to approve. Second was given by Dr. Hsia. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed a request for waiver of competency testing for reactivation of the dental license of **Henry Paul Kellum** based on Dr. Kellum having recently worked in another state as a dentist. Dr. Holt made a motion to approve. Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed a request for waiver of competency testing for reactivation of the dental license of **Kenneth Wiggins** based on Dr. Wiggins having recently worked in another state as a dentist. Dr. Holt made a motion to approve. Second was given by Ms. Fullilove. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed a request for a waiver of CPR certification due to physical debilities for **W. Paul Brakebill, Jr.** Dr. Holt made a motion to grant a waiver of CPR certification for the current cycle. Second was given by Ms. Fox. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed a request for a waiver of the continuing education and CPR requirements for the 2009-2010 cycle due to physical infirmities for **Greg Grobmeyer, D.D.S.** Dr. Fordjour made a motion to grant the waiver. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed a request for a waiver of lapsed license fees for reinstatement for **Cheryl D. Goins**. Ms. Fox made a motion to deny. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed the application of **Candice Hunley** for nitrous oxide monitoring and dental radiology. Ms. Cherry made a motion to approve both courses. Second was given by Dr. Holt. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed the radiology application of **Crystal Holloway**. Dr. Fordjour made a motion to approve. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed the radiology application of **Stephanie Deardorff**. Ms. Fox made a motion to approve. Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the new licenses, certifications, reinstatements, reactivation, and retirement applications for dentist from September 14, 2010 through January 24, 2011. Second was given by Ms. Young. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the new licenses, certifications, reinstatements, reactivation, and retirement applications for dental hygienist from September 14, 2010 through January 24, 2011. Second was given by Dr. Hsia. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the new licenses, certifications, reinstatements, reactivation, and retirement applications for dental assistants from September 14, 2010 through January 24, 2011. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

Dr. Timothy Hottel, Dean, University of Tennessee Health Science Center, reported to the Board that Dr. **Faye Frey**, D.D.S. had completed the competency evaluation previously required by the Board and recommended approval of her reinstatement application. Dr. Holt made a motion to approve. Second was given by Ms. Betty Fox. Motion Carried.

OTHER BUSINESS

Dr. Hottel requested the Board to consider changing the requirement that the director of an expanded function dental assisting program be a faculty member. Dr. Hsia made a motion to send the request to the Clinical Issues Committee for review and recommendation to the Board prior to doing a rulemaking hearing. Second was given by Dr. Smith. Motion Carried. The Board nominated Ms. Fox, Ms. Cherry, Dr. Hsia, and a representative from the Tennessee Dental Association and the University of Tennessee Health Science Center to the committee.

Due to conflicts, the Board changed the June 2011 meeting date to April 28-29, 2011.

Ms. Fox made a motion to send Dr. Holt and the Board's attorney to the 2011 Mid-Year American Association of Dental Boards (AADB) meeting April 3-4, 2011 in Chicago. Second was given by Dr. Hsia. Motion Carried. Dr. Hsia made a motion to send Dr. Holt to the Joint Commission on National dental Examinations (JCNDE) Advisory Forum meeting in connection with the AADB meeting on April 4, 2011. Second was given by Ms. Fox. Motion Carried.

CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES Ms. Marlene Fullilove made a motion to approve the continuing education course entitled "Radiolucent Lesions of the Mandible" offered by Oral Facial Surgery Group, PC. Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the continuing education course entitled "Chairside Guide to Periodontal Plastic Surgery" offered by Periodontal & Implant Associates of Middle Tennessee. Second was given by Ms. Fox. Motion Carried.

The course entitled "The 2010-2011 Medical-Dental-Legal Update" was initially approved by the Board Consultant and ratified by the Board at the September 16-17, 2010 meeting for 15 hours of credit. Based on the submission of additional information, Dr. Hsia made a motion to reconsider the September ratification. Second was given by Ms. Fullilove. Motion Carried. Dr. Hsia made a motion to approve the course for 10 hours of credit with a letter of explanation to the provider. Second was given by Ms. Fullilove. Motion Carried. (This matter was heard on the 28th.)

Gene Dennis presented the Board with a compilation of CE courses that had been previously approved by the Board as individual courses. Mr. Dennis wants to offer the courses collectively as a “boxed set”. Dr. Fordjour made a motion to have Dr. Holt review the courses as a whole package and make a recommendation to the Board. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

Dr. Hsia made a motion to approve the course entitled “Methamphetamine Awareness Class” taken by Victoria Givens for individual CE credit. Second was given by Ms. Fullilove. Motion Carried.

Dr. Hsia made a motion to approve the course entitled “Methamphetamine Awareness Class” taken by Donald Reynolds for individual CE credit. Second was given by Dr. Holt. Motion Carried.

CONCERNED DENTAL PROFESSIONALS COMMITTEE (CDPC) Dr. Wayne McElhiney submitted his Quarterly Report of Activities to the Board for review. Dr. Hsia made a motion to extend the contract with the CDPC for one year. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT: Paul David presented an administrative report to the Board showing the number of applications received and licenses issued as follows:

CLINICAL ISSUES COMMITTEE Dr. Hsia made a motion to allow the Committee time to study what constitutes appropriate training to allow dentists to use Botox in the management of cranial-facial pain. Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. Motion Carried.

ANESTHESIA COMMITTEE The Anesthesia Committee considered the course “IV Sedation for Dentistry” at its meeting on January 22, 2011. It was the consensus of the Board to defer action on this until additional information could be provided to the Committee. Dr. Holt made a motion to adopt the position of the Anesthesia Committee pertaining to the request of Dr. Michael E. Mermigas, D.D.S. from Duquesne University for approval of the course “IV Sedation for Dentistry” and defer action until additional information is provided. Second was given by Ms. Fox. Motion Carried. (January 28, 2011)

The meeting recessed at 5:00 p.m.

JANUARY 28, 2011

The meeting of the Board of Dentistry reconvened at 9:10 a.m. with all members present except Ruth Bailey, John Douglass, and Michael Tabor.

The first order of business was an Agreed Order in the matter of **Delilah A. Johnson**, D.D.S., Docket No. 17.12-110771A. Dr. Johnson entered into an Agreed Order (Docket No. 17.12-085429A) on January 27, 2006, that placed her license on probation with certain terms and conditions. Respondent failed to fulfill all the conditions contained in the referenced Order. Respondent agreed to a reprimand of her license, and to compensate the State for the costs associated with litigation of her earlier case in the amount of \$1,342.12 and to pay the costs of prosecuting this case.

The Board conducted a formal hearing in the matter of **Tiffany S. Bridges** Docket No. 17.12-110770A. Ms. Bridges was contesting the Board’s denial of her application for registration as a dental assistant at the September 16-17, 2010 meeting. The Honorable Lynn England presided as Administrative Law Judge. The State was represented by Maryam Kassae. The Respondent was present, but not represented by Counsel. At the conclusion of the hearing, Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the application for registration as a dental assistant and place the license on probation to run concurrent with the Court ordered probation (August 2011).

OFFICE OF INVESTIGATIONS REPORT Denise Moran, Director, Office of Investigations provided the Board with a report showing 143 complaints currently opened for dentists, 6 currently opened for hygienists and 18 open for dental assistants.

LEGISLATION Ms. Kassae provided the Board with a copy of Senate Bill 184 to amend *Tennessee Code Annotated* Title 4 Chapter 29 and Section 63-5-103 relative to the Board of Dentistry. This Bill reads as follows: “The governor shall consult with the Tennessee Dental Association before making any appointments to the board.” Dr. Hsia made a motion to not support the legislation. Second was given by Ms. Fox. Motion Carried.

OTHER BUSINESS Ms. Kassae requested the Board provide clarification as to who constitutes an owner of a dentist office for purposes of Rule 0460-01-.08 (1)(2). Dr. Hsia made a motion that regarding Dental Professional Corporations (D.P.C.), “owner” means a

stockholder dentist with an active Tennessee license; and regarding Dental Professional Limited Liability Companies (D.P.L.L.C.), “owner” means a member dentist with an active Tennessee license. Second was given by Ms. Fullilove. Motion Carried. Dr. Hsia made a motion that this clarification be formulated into a Policy Statement and carried forward to the rulemaking process. Second was given by Dr. Holt. Motion Carried.

Elizabeth Miller, Executive Director Health Related Boards, provided the Board with a budget report. The report showed fees collected of \$1.4 million; total expenditures of \$844,000; and a balance of \$604,000.

CONSENT ORDERS

Maryam Kassae presented the following Consent Orders:

Sherreata Rippy In the matter of Shereatta Rippy, Case Number 2010013211, Ms. Rippy stipulated to never having held a dental hygiene or a dental assistant registration in the state of Tennessee, but did perform duties that required registration as a dental hygienist or dental assistant or specialty certification. Ms. Rippy agreed to cease and desist from performing procedures that require any registration or certification until properly licensed to do so; to pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$300; and to pay the costs of the case. Dr. Holt made a motion to accept the Consent Order. Second was given by Dr. Hsia. Motion Carried.

Melinda K. Keener In the matter of Melinda K. Keener, Case #2009023151, Ms. Keener stipulated to forging prescriptions for various controlled substances. Ms. Keener agreed to the revocation of her registration to practice as a dental assistant in Tennessee and pay the costs of the matter. Dr. Holt made a motion to accept the Consent Order. Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. Motion Carried.

Kathryn T. McGlasson In the matter of Kathryn T. McGlasson, Case #2010006711, Ms. McGlasson stipulated to obtaining unauthorized prescriptions for various controlled substances. Ms. McGlasson agreed to the revocation of her license and to pay the costs of the matter. Ms. Fox made a motion to approve. Second was given by Dr. Holt. Motion Carried.

Timothy J. McNeely In the matter of Timothy J. McNeely, D.D.S., Case #2010009071, Dr. McNeely had entered into a Consent Order dated September 12, 2008, and subsequent Order dated September 17, 2010. Respondent petitioned the Board for an Order of Compliance after completing a long-term inpatient treatment program and providing clinical documentation supporting his return to the practice of dentistry under compliance guidelines of the CDPC. Dr. Holt made a motion to lift the suspension and place the license on probation for a period of not less than five years as per the referenced Consent Order dated September 17, 2010. Second was given by Dr. Hsia. Motion Carried.

Annie Yvette Guerrero Ms. Guerrero petitioned the Board for an Order of Compliance after proving to the satisfaction of the Board that she had complied with all the terms and conditions

of her criminal probation which expired February 17, 2010. Dr. Holt made a motion to approve. Second was given by Ms. Fullilove. Motion Carried.

Jennifer Johnson Adam In the matter of Jennifer Johnson Adam, D.D.S., Docket #17.12-099760A, Dr. Adam signed an Agreed Order dated January 9, in which she agreed to certain terms and conditions. Dr. Adam proved to the satisfaction of the Board that she had complied with all the provisions of the disciplinary order previously issued and requested an Order of Compliance. Dr. Holt made a motion to approve. Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. Motion Carried.

Kayla Marie Hughes Ms. Hughes, D.A., petitioned the Board for an Order of Compliance after proving to the satisfaction of the Board that she had complied with all the provisions of her criminal probation which expired June 6, 2010. Dr. Holt made a motion to approve. Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. Motion Carried.

Dean Johnson Dr. Johnson petitioned the Board for relief of the conditions placed upon his license by Order dated September 21, 2006. Dr. John Douglass, in his capacity as Board Consultant, recommended a finding of an impossibility to perform. After discussion by the Board, the following motions were made and carried: 1) Dr. Fordjour – remaining term of probation placed on a stay; Second was given by Ms. Fullilove. 2) Dr. Holt - the granted stay of probation will expire at the next Board meeting, September 8, 2011; Second was given by Ms. Fullilove. 3) Dr. Holt – during the length of the stay, Petitioner must comply with the other terms and conditions of the previous order; Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. 4) Dr Holt – Petitioner must pay the remaining portion of the civil penalties (\$14,000); Second was given by Ms. Fox. 5) Ms. Fullilove – Petitioner must appear before the Board at the September, 2011 meeting to show compliance with any and all the provisions of the previously issued Orders and this Order; Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. 6) Dr. Holt – if Petitioner does not appear or fails to prove to the satisfaction of the Board that he has complied with any and all the provisions of the previously issued Orders and this Order, the Board may place the Petitioner's license on probation for the remaining portion of the probationary period (seven months and twenty five days); Second was given by Ms. Fullilove. 7) Dr. Holt – if Petitioner appears at the September 2011 meeting and can prove to the satisfaction of the Board that he has complied with all the provisions of the previously issued Orders and this Order, the Board may waive the remaining portion of the probationary period and issue an Order of Compliance; Second was given by Dr. Fordjour. 8) Dr. Holt – this action taken by the board shall have no bearing on current or future investigations regarding conducts in violation of the statutes and rules of the Board of Dentistry; Second was given by Ms. Fullilove.

CERTIFICATION / EQUIVALENCY COURSES:

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the following certification courses for **Administration and Monitoring of Nitrous Oxide**: Dentedonline, Interfaith Dental Clinic, University of Tennessee and Remington College-Nashville campus. Second was given by Dr. Hsia. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the following certification courses for **Dental Radiology**: Dentedonline, Anderson County Dental Assisting, Nashville Dental Society, Dental Radiology Certification Program, E.W. Professional Career Training Center, University of Tennessee,

College of Dentistry and Eight District Dental Society. Second was given by Dr. Hsia. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the following certification courses for **Monitoring of Nitrous Oxide**: Chattanooga State Technical Community College, Dentedonline, E.W. Professional Career Training Center, Interfaith Dental Clinic, Eighth District Dental Society, Northeast State Technical Community College, Southeastern Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, University of Tennessee College of Dentistry, Volunteer State Community College and Remington College-Nashville. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the following certification courses for **Sealant Application**: Chattanooga State Technical Community College, Dentedonline, E.W. Professional Career Training Center, Northeast State Technical Community College, Tennessee Technology Center at Knoxville, Remington College-Nashville, and University of Tennessee College of Dentistry. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the following certification courses for **Coronal Polishing**: Dentedonline, E.W. Professional Career Training Center, Tennessee Technology Center at Knoxville, University of Tennessee-Memphis, Concorde Career College and Remington College-Nashville. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to approve the following certification courses for **Local Anesthesia** University of Tennessee-Memphis and Chattanooga State Community College. Motion Carried.

Dr. Holt made a motion to **approve** the following **administration and monitoring of nitrous oxide** course as **equivalent**: Western Kentucky University for Allison Genton, University of Missouri-Kansas City for Amy Cuba, University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for Maeve Kamerman, and Northeast Mississippi Community College for Jenna Haven. Second was given by Ms. Cherry. Motion Carried.
