Adopt the Emergency Medical Responder scope, this is the current First Responder level, in TN. Donna, Jim Williamson Jeff Wright are assigned to draft rules for certification

Adopt the Emergency Medical Technician scope, Darren Webb, David Fraizer and are assigned to draft rules for licensure

Adopt Emergency Medical Technician Advanced scope. Roger Paul Chad Graham, Randy White and Randal Kirby assigned to draft the rules for licensure

Adopt the Paramedic scope, Jimmie Edwards, Kenny Wilkerson assigned to draft rules for licensure

All drafts are to be reviewed by committee at next meeting.

The committee also voted not to require Emergency Medical Technician license before entrance into the Emergency Medical Technician Advanced training. However Emergency Medical Technician Advanced license will be required before entry into Paramedic training.
