Rule 1370-02-.09 Renewal of License is amended by deleting subparagraph (2)(b) and subparagraph (2)(c) and substituting instead the following language as new subparagraph (2)(b) and subparagraph (2)(c) and is further amended by adding a new subparagraph (2)(d) so that, as amended, the new subparagraphs (2)(b), (2)(c), and (2)(d) shall read as follows:

- (b) Licenses expired for less than one (1) calendar year may be reinstated in the following manner:
 - 1. Pay the past due renewal fee and the state regulatory fee, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.06;
 - 2. Pay the Late Renewal fee, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.06;
 - 3. Provide documentation of successfully completing continuing education requirements for the year in which the license was expired, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.12; and
 - 4. Provide current calibration of equipment certificates for each audiometer used at the licensee's place of business, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.12.
- (c) Licenses expired for one (1) calendar year or more may be reinstated in the following manner:
 - 1. Pay a renewal fee, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.06, that equals the amount of the current renewal fee plus the state regulatory fee times two;
 - 2. Pay the Late Renewal fee, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.06;
 - 3. Provide documentation of successfully completing twenty (20) hours of continuing education, which shall include two (2) hours of Tennessee statutes and rules, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.12;
 - 4. Provide current calibration of equipment certificates for each audiometer used at the licensee's place of business, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.12; and
 - 5. Cause to be submitted to the Council's Administrative Office, directly from the vendor identified in the Council's reinstatement materials, the results of a criminal background check.
- (d) License reinstatement applications hereunder shall be treated as license applications, and review and decisions shall be governed by Rule 1370-02-.07.

Rule 1370-02-.11 Retirement and Reactivation of License is amended by deleting paragraph (3) in its entirety, including its subparts, and substituting instead the following for new paragraph (3) so that as amended, the new paragraph (3) shall read as follows:

- (3) A person who holds a retired license may apply to reactivate the license in the following manner:
 - (a) Licenses retired for two (2) years or less.
 - 1. Submit a written request to the Council's Administrative Office for licensure reactivation;

2. Pay the current licensure renewal fee and the state regulatory fee, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.06. If reactivation is requested prior to the expiration of one (1) year from the date of retirement, the Council will require payment of the late renewal fee, the current licensure renewal fee, and the state regulatory fee, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.06;
3. Provide documentation of successfully completing continuing education requirements, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.12; and
4. Cause to be submitted to the Council's Administrative Office, directly from the vendor identified in the Council's reactivation materials, the results of a criminal background check.

(b) Licenses retired for more than two (2) years.

1. Submit a written request to the Council's Administrative Office for licensure reactivation;
2. Pay a renewal fee, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.06, that equals the amount of the current licensure renewal fee plus the state regulatory fee times two;
3. Provide documentation of successfully completing twenty (20) hours of continuing education, which shall include two (2) hours of Tennessee statutes and rules, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.12; and
4. Cause to be submitted to the Council's Administrative Office, directly from the vendor identified in the Council's reactivation materials, the results of a criminal background check.

Rule 1370-02-.12 Continuing Education, Calibration Certificates, and Bills of Sale is amended by adding a new part (1)(a)3. as follows, so that as amended, the new part (1)(a)3. shall read as follows:

3. For new licensees, submitting proof of successful completion of the written and practical examinations, pursuant to Rule 1370-02-.08, shall be considered proof of sufficient preparatory education to constitute continuing education credit for the first calendar year of licensure.

Rule 1370-02-.12 Continuing Education, Calibration Certificates, and Bills of Sale is amended by deleting part (4)(a)2. in its entirety and substituting instead the following for new part (4)(a)2. so that as amended, the new part (4)(a)2. shall read as follows:

2. An individual who requests reactivation of a license which has been retired for more than two (2) years must submit, along with the reactivation request, verification which indicates the attendance and successful completion of twenty (20) hours of continuing education, which shall include two (2) hours of Tennessee statutes and rules. The continuing education hours must have been started and successfully completed within the two (2) years immediately preceding the date of the requested reactivation.

Rule 1370-02-.12 Continuing Education, Calibration Certificates, and Bills of Sale is amended by deleting subparagraph (4)(c) in its entirety and substituting instead the following for new subparagraph (4)(c) so that as amended, the new subparagraph (4)(c) shall read as follows:

- (c) Reinstatement of Expired Licensure – An individual who requests reinstatement of a license which has been expired for more than one (1) calendar year must submit, along with the reinstatement request, verification which indicates the attendance and successful completion of twenty (20) hours of continuing education, which shall include two (2) hours of Tennessee statutes and rules. The continuing education hours must have been started and successfully completed within the two (2) years immediately preceding the date of the requested reactivation.

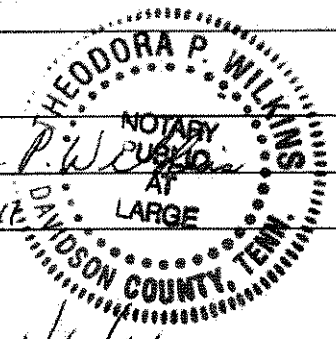
