Rulemaking Hearing re Rule 1000-4-.10  
Tamper Resistant Prescriptions

9:15 a.m. - Alison Cleaves opened the rulemaking hearing summarizing the rulemaking process, the history of the tamper-resistant rule and the language of the rule itself. The tamper-resistant rules emphasize security in written prescriptions. There were no public comments. The Tennessee Medical Association (TMA) filed a letter of comment requesting that under definitions, "prescriber" be defined as "nurse practitioner" instead of "advanced practice nurse with a certificate of fitness to prescribe." Historically, the Board has interpreted the term nurse practitioner to be synonymous with advanced practice nurse. TMA also spoke in opposition to language about FAX and electronic prescriptions related to the requirement for the prescriber to note in the chart the mode of transmission of the prescription. After discussion, Brennan moved and seconded by C. Thompson to accept the TMA recommendation regarding transmission of FAX and electronic prescription consistent with the Board of Medical Examiner's (BME) vote, but not to adopt the TMA recommendation relating to definitions, also consistent with BME. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.
