Ms. Vickerstaff, chair, called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. A sufficient number of board members were present to constitute a quorum.

**Review Minutes**

Upon review of the February 4, 2005 minutes, Ms. Wolkhamer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Esposito, to approve the minutes as written. The motion carried.

**Contested Case Hearing for Robert Reddig, CMSW**

Administrative Law Judge, James A. Hornsby, presided over the case hearing for Robert Reddig, LCSW. Ms. Rainey Irwin, Assistant General Counsel, represented the State and Mr. Daniel Warlick, Esq. represented the Respondent.

Judge Hornsby asked the board members to introduce themselves and stated that this hearing is continued from the September 8, 2004 board meeting.

Upon conclusion of the hearing, Ms. Wolkhamer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Fleming, to accept the first two findings of fact as written and the third findings of fact upon adding the language “inappropriately.” The motion carried.

Ms. Esposito made a motion, seconded by Ms. Wolkhamer, to accept the fourth finding of fact as written. The motion carried.

Ms. Wolkhamer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Fleming, to accept the fifth finding of fact upon changing the language “other sessions.” The motion carried.

Ms. Wolkhamer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Bowers-Mitchell, to accept the sixth findings of fact as written. The motion carried.

Ms. Morris made a motion, seconded by Ms. Wolkhamer, to accept the seventh findings of fact upon changing the language “during a particular session.” The motion carried.

Ms. Fleming made a motion, seconded by Ms. Wolkhamer, to accept the eighth findings of fact as written. The motion carried.

Ms. Wolkhamer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Morris, to accept the ninth findings of fact as written. The motion carried.

Ms. Wolkhamer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Esposito, to add a tenth findings of fact that Respondent failed to self-report impairment after the relationship was compromised. The motion carried.

Upon review of the conclusions of law, Ms. Wolkhamer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Fleming, to accept the conclusions of law as written. The motion carried.

Upon discussion of the disciplinary action, Ms. Wolkhamer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Esposito, to assess Mr. Reddig a \$500 civil penalty for each of the seven charges for a total of \$3,500. The motion carried.

Ms. Fleming made a motion, seconded by Ms. Morris, to place Mr. Reddig on a one year probationary period and have Mr. Reddig contract with the Tennessee Medical Foundation with quarterly reports to the board on his progress. The motion carried.

Ms. Wolkhamer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Morris, to have Mr. Reddig attend bimonthly AA meetings and obtain monthly clinical supervision. The motion carried.

Ms. Vickerstaff stated the Tennessee Board of Social Worker Certification and Licensure took this action in order to enforce the statutory laws and rules governing the professional practice of social work in the State of Tennessee and protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the State of Tennessee.
