

MARITAL STATUS AT DX

Description:

THIS IS A SUPPLEMENTARY/ RECOMMENDED DATA ITEM

Code for the patient's marital status at the time of diagnosis for the tumor being reported.

Rationale:

Marital status is linked to sexual activity and to hormonal status as a surrogate for parity. Incidence and survival of certain cancers varies by marital status. The item also helps in patient identification.

General Guidelines:

If the patient has multiple tumors, marital status may be different for each tumor.

Persons of the opposite sex living together as part of a long-term personal relationship would be coded to 2, Married (including common law).

Persons of the same sex living together as part of a long-term personal relationship would be coded according to their legal status (usually single, separated, divorced, or widowed).

Codes	Description
1	Single (never married).
2	Married (including common law).
3	Separated.
4	Divorced.
5	Widowed.
9	Unknown.

MARITAL STATUS AT DX (Cont'd)

Abstract Plus:

In the CURRENT VALUE box, type the appropriate code for marital status of the patient at the time of diagnosis.

MEDICAL RECORD NUMBER

Description:

THIS IS A REQUIRED DATA ITEM

Records the medical record number used by the facility to identify the patient. The COC *FORDS Manual* instructs registrars to record numbers assigned by the facility's Health Information Management (HIM) Department, not department-specific numbers.

Rationale:

This number identifies the patient in a facility. A central registry can also use it to identify multiple reports on the same patient.

Codes (Special codes in addition to the medical record number)	Description
UNK	Medical record number unknown.
RT	Radiation therapy department patient without HIM number.
SU	One-day surgery clinic patient without HIM number.

Note: Other standard abbreviations may be used to indicate departments within the facility for patients without HIM numbers assigned.

MILITARY RECORD NO SUFFIX

Source of Standard COC

Description:

THIS IS A SUPPLEMENTARY/RECOMMENDED DATA ITEM

Patient identifier used by military hospitals to record the relationship of the patient to the sponsor.

Rationale:

This data item is used in addition to the medical record number in military facilities to identify the patient's relationship to the military sponsor.

General Guidelines:

Code the Family Member Prefix (FMP) assigned by the military medical facility.

Codes	Description
Blank	Not applicable, medical record number not from a military hospital.
01-19	Child.
20	Sponsor.
30-39	Spouse.
40-44	Mother.
45-49	Father.
50-54	Mother-in-law.
55-59	Father-in-law.
60-69	Other eligible dependents.
98	Civilian emergency (Air Force/ Navy).
99	Not classified elsewhere/ stillborn.
