

ADDENDUM TO THE “WIC VENDOR HANDBOOK FOR 2010 –2012”

Due to needed clarification and corrections required by USDA, page 34 of the handbook is being changed as follows:

Under “Adverse actions for which the vendor may request a hearing before an administrative judge from the Administrative Procedures Division of the Tennessee Secretary of State’s office:”

“denial of authorization as a vendor because their prices on approved foods were not competitive, they did not have the required minimum stock of approved foods, the majority of annual total gross sales are not derived from staple foods, or they were trying to circumvent a previous sanction”

Is being replaced by:

“denial of authorization as a vendor because they did not have the required minimum stock of approved foods or they were trying to circumvent a previous sanction”

Under “Adverse actions for which the vendor may request an administrative review “:

The following are being added:

“denial of authorization as a vendor because their prices on approved foods were not competitive”

“denial of authorization as a vendor because the majority of annual total gross sales are not derived from staple foods”

The following is being deleted:

“disqualification because of a trafficking conviction”

And is being replaced by:

“disqualification because of a trafficking/illegal sales conviction”
